## EDITOR'S NOTE

The European Union is a complex social system, dependent on the dynamics of its environment. The analysis of this environment and its interaction with the Union allows a short-term forecast of its further development. The benefits of globalization combined with raising security risks. The new environment of the EU, consisting of partners/competitors (such as the USA, China, Japan...), international organizations (WTO) and multinational companies, has no clear main characteristics. It is unclear whether it is hegemonic, multi-polar or chaotic. It is dynamic, unpredictable and difficult to be analyzed and controlled.

EU response to the new type of external influence can not take place entirely in the pattern of the Cold War. The Integration becomes a process of continuous playback of the community around the invariable set of common values. Most probably there will emerge a center for strategic management, working more on the principle of coordination rather than subordination. The institutional structure of the Union will become more flexible, based mostly on horizontal links. The gap between formal and informal structure will grow further and the institutional reforms of the Union will become permanent. The issue is dedicate to the institutional development of the EU.
